



GPA Citizenship Rubric

Being present and ready to learn is crucial to academic success!

At GPA, we believe being a productive citizen in your learning community is the key to overall success and must be directly tied to our Code of Conduct to uphold school culture. GPA students sent to the Office of Student Engagement (OSE) may receive a lowered overall citizenship grade for that grading period in the class the incident took place or in all classes depending on the situation. GPA students involved in a suspension (in or out of school) will receive a lowered overall citizenship grade for that grading period in all classes.

Attendance & Behavior Indicators

- Attends class everyday on time. (Communicates effectively if an absence or tardy occurs/makes up work and ensures attendance matters are cleared/excused. If a student has more than 3 unexcused tardies in a quarter, they may receive an "S" or lower depending on the total number.)
- Shares compliments at appropriate times
- Shares academic comments
- Makes eye contact at appropriate times
- Shows respect of others' opinions, comments and ideas
- Responds with "Yes, ma'am" and "No, sir" at appropriate times
- Does not brag when winning or show anger when losing
- Stays on task
- Lets others learn
- Brings positive attention to himself/herself
- Wears GPA uniform with pride
- Adheres to the Electronic Device and No Gum Policies
